

PLAN FOR THE RECEPTION AND HANDLING OF VESSELS WASTE

1 LOCATION PLAN

Marina Palamós provides users with different disposal points for domestic, hazardous and non-hazardous waste distributed throughout the marina, with the aim of ensuring proper segregation and subsequent management.





2 TYPES OF MANAGED WASTE

The types of waste collected and managed at the port are summarized below.

2.1 SELECTIVE COLLECTION OF MUNICIPALLY MANAGED DOMESTIC WASTE

- General and organic waste – Grey container
- Packaging and plastics – Yellow container
- Paper and cardboard – Blue container
- Glass – Green container

2.2 COLLECTION OF HAZARDOUS WASTE WITH AN AUTHORIZED MANAGER

This waste must be deposited at the Blue Point located at the boatyard:

- Contaminated rags
- Paint waste
- Contaminated containers
- Oil filters
- Aerosols
- Residual oil
- Aqueous bilge liquids
- Water containing hydrocarbons and bilge water
- Fluorescent tubes
- Electronic scrap
- Antifouling waste
- Halogenated sludge

The fuel station has a bilge water suction system and also provides a collection point for absorbents and contaminated rags.

2.3 COLLECTION OF NON-HAZARDOUS WASTE WITH AN AUTHORIZED MANAGER

This waste must be deposited at the Blue Point located at the boatyard:

- Wood
- Scrap metal
- Zinc anodes
- Small electrical appliances
- Alkaline batteries
- Sanding dust from paint

3 CONTACT WITH THE PORT AND SERVICE MANAGERS

To contact the persons responsible for managing waste generated by boats based at the port or making a stopover, go report to the Capitanía offices. Public service hours:

November to April:

- Monday to Friday: 09:00 – 18:00
- Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays: 10:00 – 14:00

May to October:

- Monday to Sunday: 09:00 – 19:00

For any doubt, query, or emergency, users may report to the Capitanía building or communicate via VHF channel 9, 24 hours a day.

4 WASTE DELIVERY PROCEDURE

For domestic-like waste (general and organic, packaging and plastics, paper and cardboard, and glass), users can deposit it directly in the containers distributed throughout the marina.

For special waste (hazardous or non-hazardous) that must be deposited at the Blue Point located at the boatyard, users must go to the boatyard, where marina personnel will provide access to the recycling point. Boatyard hours:

October to March:

- Monday to Friday: 08:00 – 17:00
- Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays: 08:00 – 14:00

April to September:

- Monday to Friday: 08:00 – 19:00
- Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays: 08:00 – 17:00

For the suction of wastewater and bilge water, users must go to the fuel station, where marina personnel will assist with the operation of the suction system. Fuel station hours:

June to September: 09:00 – 21:00

October to May: 09:00 – 17:00

5 COSTS RECOVERY

Marina Palamós provides free use of the black water and bilge water suction system for port users, as well as containers for domestic-like waste

However, for waste generated at the boatyard the port establishes a specific treatment fee for boat waste, set at €2.50 (plus VAT) per meter of the vessel's length.
